- Developed and maintain a dynamic, database driven web site for outdoor enthusiasts of Northern California [www.SierraOutdoorRecreation.com]. This site is comprised of a template based framework to display a wide range of images and text for outdoor activities plus a content management system that allows authors, editors, photographers and cartographers to easily add and update the information. This site utilizes ColdFusion, XHTML, CSS, JavaScript, DHTML, XML, XSLT, Flash and Microsoft SQL Server 2000.
- Created and support flagship internet application to provide recruiters with concise information on blood drives. Using ColdFusion, HTML, CSS, JavaScript and DHTML, this application pulls data from a Oracle database and displays a report showing details of all the mobile blood drives scheduled for a given month in a calendar format. The interface includes controls to view previous and future months; to drill down into a multiple page display of a drive's details with forms to update the data and to access Crystal and HTML reports.
- Built and update a web tool to provide interface between handheld computers and an
 enterprise data entry application. Using ColdFusion, HTML, JavaScript and ScreenSurfer,
 this tool collects a data file downloaded from a handheld PC to a client workstation. It then
 processes the data into an Oracle table from where it is processed with ScreenSurfer code
 to write to data access screens through telnet using VT100 to a SafeTrace installation.
- Prototyped and implemented custom e-commerce application for a small brick and mortar audio and video store. Created a prototype application in both ASP and ColdFusion. Upon the decision to use ColdFusion, built a fully functional site with ColdFusion, HTML and JavaScript to display products and allow customers to order online. This included administrative functions to allow the content to be easily edited and updated.
- Built a Microsoft Access database of rocket propulsion systems and launch vehicles marketing information. Then with ColdFusion and HTML, built an interface to allow marketing managers to view, filter and drill down into the data as well as administer it through a corporate intranet.
